SEMINAR OUTLINE

Most Christians don't feel fruitful in the everyday places they spend time during the week – whether that's work, home, the gym or the lunch club. This seminar opens our eyes to see our daily lives through a biblical lens. We discover that when we model godly character, make good work, minister grace and love, bring a shalom culture, speak up for truth and justice, and share the gospel, we can be fruitful for Christ every day.

QUESTIONS

1. Do you feel fruitful as a Christian in your workplace, college, home, or retirement?

Watch the video and pause it at 19:45 minutes.

2. What would you have said to Curt?

Restart video at 21:12 minutes (<https://tinyurl.com/msfdcbue>) and watch until 59:12 minutes.

3. Share key elements of the work you do during the week – paid and unpaid – and allow the other members of the group to name them using biblical categories: 'This...is...that'.
4. Following Mark's example of the barista, imagine how the 6Ms could work out in your 9-5?
5. Have you ever prayed about a problem at work? What happened?
6. Think about a time when God worked through you. Which Ms did you notice?

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REFLECTION/PRAYER

- As a group, pray through the elements of your work that you discussed in question 3. Thank God for the work you see him doing in each other's lives.
- With a prayer partner, pray regularly for the salvation of one person that God has given you a burden for. Pray for opportunities to demonstrate God's love, share the gospel message and, one day, for that person to become a Christian.
- Consider the culture of your frontline - one of the places you spend significant time during the week - and identify any problems. Pray about a kingdom antidote and put it into practice.
